

Parent Tips & Hints Swaddling and Sleeping Bags

We hope that you find some of the following suggestions, from other DDH parents helpful.

Swaddling

- Always allow the legs to move into their natural position.
- Swaddling/wrapping of arms only is recommended with loose covering of legs only.
- Incorrect techniques can lead to unnecessary incidences of hip dysplasia.

- Always allow the legs to move into their natural frog-legged position.
- Many commercial brands of sleeping bags, in the bigger size, will fit over the harnesses and braces.
